I continued with similar duties, but worked primarily with the Deschutes Public Library team to develop architectural renderings for several library projects throughout the county. In the summer of 2023, I was contracted to Olson Kundig (remained an Miller Hull employee), and largely focused on site research, material research, renderings, presentation design, and floor plan schemes.

This position involved the coordination of both private and government bids involving interior design services and furniture purchases across Oahu, Maui, Hawai'i, and Kaua'i. I also supported the sales team by designing presentation templates and marketing materials.
